- ***Need help with your job search?***

Join PUP's Jobs Club to get help you with your job search. Look through our job listings. Get support from others who are unemployed. PUP also offers individualized career counseling and has a free fax and computers available for resume and cover letter writing and internet job search. The Jobs Club meets at 10 AM every Tuesday morning. Call ahead for more information or just show up.

- ***Having trouble paying your mortgage?***

PUP has counselors that may be able to help you qualify for state loan programs to help you with your mortgage payments. Also, they may be able to help you negotiate affordable arrangements with your mortgage company.

- ***Having problems with health care coverage?***

PUP's counselors will work to connect you to free health centers, get you low cost insurance or help you or your family if you need hospital care.

- ***Denied Unemployment Benefits?***

PUP's Unemployment Compensation Project provides trained University of Pennsylvania law students and PUP staff to represent workers at unemployment compensation referee hearings.
